You may ride multiple tests in a TOC (Test of Choice) class, please specify level & test for each ride. You may enter Show Jumping Classes multiple times, first go will count toward class placing. Classes may be combined, split or dropped & those *in italics may be ridden in a small arena* at the organizers discretion. All dressage tests may be called. Combined tests will follow USEA rules. Gaited tests will follow the rules of the NWHA. Western classes will follow AMHA rules. All divisions will be run per USEF rules.

**Approved helmets required for all junior riders and for anyone jumping. Medical armbands and protective vests strongly recommended for jumping rounds.**

**Negative coggins & waivers required for all entries.**

**ORDER OF GO:** Combined Test Dressage will run first, followed by Stadium in an adjacent area. Dressage Only classes will run after Combined Test Dressage tests, with class 13 being the final class in the dressage arena. Jumper Classes will follow Combined Test Jumping, at the appropriate heights. Gambler's Choice will be the final jumping class of the day.

**GAMBLER'S CHOICE:** No set course, heights range from 18"-3'6", with points assigned to each jump. Fences may be jumped a maximum of 2 times. Nockdowns do not receive points and that fence may not be jumped again. Flags must be observed & fences jumped in the correct direction or the rider will be eliminated. Each rider has 60 seconds. Point total determines placing. Entry fees will be used for payback and divided as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> 30%, 2<sup>nd</sup> 25%, 3<sup>rd</sup> 20%, 4<sup>th</sup> 15%, 5<sup>th</sup> 10%.

**IN HAND:** Please see [www.BDCTA.com](http://www.BDCTA.com) for the pattern & more information. This class will be held in the dressage arena after all dressage rides are completed. The class may be split by age of horse if entries warrant, please indicated horse's age on the entry form.

**REFUNDS:** Entry fees will be refunded with a veterinary letter at any time. Other circumstances will be considered on an individual basis. No refunds for inclement weather.

**FIRST AID:** At BDCTA events where jumping will take place, paramedics and an ambulance will be on call. Vandiver/Sterrett Volunteer Fire & Rescue will be on location during jumping classes.

**CONCESSIONS:** Rolling Hills will have breakfast and lunch concessions available.

**NON-COMPETING HORSES:** Will be permitted on show premises. Please inform the receiving secretary and provide a \$10 fee and a copy of a negative Coggins test for each non-competing horse.

**OPENING/CLOSING DATES:** Entries open now & close Sept 10<sup>th</sup> IN SECRETARY'S HAND.

**ARENAS:** Fabulous new footing in all 3 arenas! Both outside Dressage and Jumping arenas with drainage for all weather riding. Dressage warm up in the covered arena, Stadium warm up on grass.

**AWARDS:** Ribbons will be awarded for places 1-6 in each class. Champion and Reserve Champion for each level will be awarded if entries warrant.

**STABLING:** Limited stabling available. Contact Peggy at Rolling Hills directly 205-365-6961.

**TRAILER PARKING:** Designated areas only—look for the signs. Please use back gate.

**ATTIRE:** No coats required. Braiding optional. Tack and apparel should meet USEF guidelines, with accommodations for pleasure, western & gaited participants detailed on the website. Gaited riders may show in english or western tack.

**HELMETS:** We strongly encourage all riders to wear helmets at all times when mounted. ALL JUNIORS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR AN APPROVED HELMET WITH HARNESS AT ALL TIME WHEN MOUNTED AT ALL BDCTA COMPETITIONS/ EVENTS. An approved helmet is required for ALL riders when jumping. Medical armbands and safety vests are strongly encouraged.

**MISCELLANEOUS:** All dogs must be on a leash and stay in the show area only. The show will be conducted following USEF/USDF/USEA rules, with NWA & AMHA rules for the gaited & western divisions.

I, \_\_\_\_\_(Rider), am aware that riding, jumping and other activities involving horses are hazardous activities and I am voluntarily participating in these activities and/or instruction with knowledge of the danger involved, and hereby agree to accept any and all risks of injury or death. Furthermore, the undersigned acknowledges and understands that horseback riding or any other participation in activities organized, run, or offered by ROLLING HILLS EQUSTRAIN CENTER may involve substantial risk of bodily injury, property damage and other dangers including, but not limited to, bodily injury or death resulting from kicks and bites, falling off horses or horses falling on Rider, being dragged by a foot caught in the stirrups, Rider being thrown by horse, equipment failure or collision with horses or vehicles or other inanimate objects.
